- We continue to replace water meters that are older than 10 years old as they can become inefficient. If you receive a letter to schedule an appointment, please call customer service and we will be happy to accommodate your schedule. If an appointment is not scheduled, you may receive a second letter as a reminder. Your participation and cooperation is greatly appreciated.
- The Mass-DOT drainage project on Route 12 (Main Street), in the area of 620 to 624 Main St., was completed. A section of water main in this area was relocated to accommodate the new culvert.
- We are also continuing our coordination assistance with contractors working on the Town's drainage projects on Charlton St., Clover St., and Locust St. The Town will be paving these roads once the drainage work is complete.
- We are making preparations for our fall Customer Advisory Board (CAB) Meeting to be scheduled in October. Be on the look out for an invitation if you are on the Customer Advisory Board, and please contact our Manager of Operations, Francis King, if you have any interest serving on the Board.


We are currently making preparations to perform our annual hydrant maintenance and flushing

Weather Trends


Weather Trends

Precipitation for August 2018 was 5.90 inches, which is 1.78 inches above the historic average precipitation for the month of August. Cumulative precipitation for the year through the month of August is 36.25 inches, which is 4.55 inches above average. Recent precipitation has allowed our aquifer to remain at normal groundwater levels for this time year, and surplus levels at our Millbury Ave groundwater supply well.

Water Supply and Demand

Water demands for August 2018 were normal for this time of year. The average amount of water pumped from our sources to meet demands in August 2018 was 720,000 gallons per day (gpd). The cumulative annual usage for the year through August (688,000 gpd) is also less then average. We anticipate that water demands will decrease as we move into the fall and winter. We are confident that we will be able to meet our customer's needs. Some statistical pumping information for the month of August
